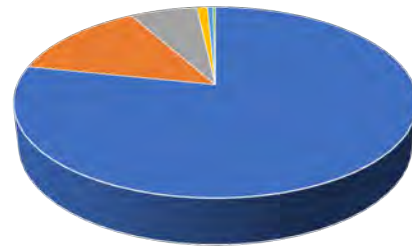

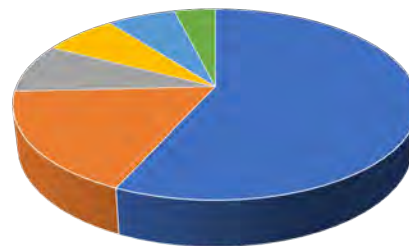


Source of Funds
